PL93/15 Minutes of the meeting held on 5th October, 2015:

It was proposed by Cllr. Bloomfield, seconded by Cllr. Linnette and agreed that minutes of the meeting held on 5th October, 2015 be signed as a true record.

The refurbishment of the bus shelter is on-going.

IT WAS PROPOSED BY CLLR REGAN AND SECONDED BY CLLR LINNETTE THAT THE CHAIR OF PLANNING SHOULD COLLATE THE VIEWS OF PARISH COUNCIL MEMBERS AND PRESENT A PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE TO THE FULL COUNCIL ON MONDAY, 26TH OCTOBER FOR ITS CONSIDERATION. This was CARRIED by 6 votes (Cllrs Sherwen,

Linnette, Mulcock, Bloomfield, Stead and Regan) with 2 abstentions (Cllrs Hales & Barrett) as District Councillors.
