It was noted that the Grass Cutting Contract is to be reviewed at the end of the first year. Current contractor to be requested to provide regular invoices in a format to be provided by the Parish Office.

MA033/18 Allotment Matters: To receive updates and consider actions.

a) To consider a report on water usage.

Noted that recent water bill was 10 x higher than previous bills. Allotment Association to address this at AGM on 19 February. Allotment holders to be made aware of the increase with a request to avoid excessive water usage. Future high water costs may have to be passed on to allotment holders.

Note 1:

There will be some cost savings in certain budget areas e.g. salaries, insurance, line marking, grounds maintenance. Some of these savings will need to be allocated to other areas where there are budget shortfalls, most notably utilities, but there is an anticipated surplus that could be available for reallocation against maintenance spend items (subject to agreement by the Parish Council). Only the balance would need to be taken out of Asset Mgt or Community Benefit reserves. Current forecasts are that overspends can be absorbed by savings eleswhere/unbudgeted income. It should not be necessary to use reserves although this will need to be monitored.

In 2019/20

Would prefer to allocate an amount in the budget for unplanned maintenance costs and allocate from this based on priority. The AMR could be kept for asset replacement or major maintenance. Ideally AMR expenditure should be planned (to an extent) with an attempt made to tie this into the Fixed Asset Register over time.

Three of the grounds maintenance contracts were re-tendered in 2018 and there have been adjustments since then. The tasks included in the contracts have been bundled differently to the original budget allocation. Budget allocations have been adjusted on Edge as best we can to allow tracking.

MD Landscapes has the Grass Cutting Contract - so far we have only received one invoice and it was not clear from the invoice how the costs relate back to the contract.

Generally, in total, we appear to have more than adequate budget to cover grounds maintenance costs. Although we still need to get a better understanding of what additional works might be needed before we reallocate the balance elsewhere, it is currently forecast that savings will be in the region of £4,000 against budget.

There is also another belly in the pipework between IC1 downstream to IC2 this belly is nearly 6 meters in length.

Because these bellies won't allow the foul to flow away it causes deposits to sit there in the belly which then slowly gets worse over time.

We recommend excavate and replacing pipe work with new UPVC pipework's this will remove the bend in the piep and restore flow back to normal, re lining may help improve flows but cannot confirm how affective it will be.


