One important thing to remember is that each stream is different. A "one size fits all" approach will not work. The strategy should engage with local experts who know their streams intimately. Advice from the Environment Agency and Water Companies needs to be carefully reviewed as, in my experience, their views are often selective and influenced by other agendas whether political or economic.
