## Quotation 1 – On Point Carpentry & Joinery

To remove, dispose of and replace the run down oak posts and rails in the centre of the village.

All post will be out of **Green Oak** and have the same curved tops as current posts, all morticed and Tenoned together and held tight with oak dowels, all posts concreted in to ensure they do not sink.

**TOTAL (including VAT): £7,104.00**

## Quotation 2 – Willards

Install Hardwood **Oak** Post & Rail Fence – War Memorial Side

- To match existing fence like for like (4-way weather top posts available at same cost if preferred)
- Removal and disposal of existing fence
- Installation of 25 Oak posts 100x140mm rounded top. Approx height 600mm
- Installation of Oak rails 75x50mm. Approx centres 2.15m
- Make good of area as required

Install Hardwood **Oak** Post & Rail Fence – By Butchers Shop

- To match existing fence like for like (4-way weather top posts available at same cost if preferred)
- Removal and disposal of existing fence
- Installation of 22 Oak posts 100x140mm rounded top. Approx height 650mm
- Installation of Oak rails 75x50mm. Approx centres 2.15m
- Make good of tarmac areas as required

**TOTAL (including VAT): £7,5050.41**

## Quotation 3 – Mike Watson (Meldreth Landscapes)

The price to take down & clear existing fencing, supply and fit new **Oak** fencing to match the old, leave clear & tidy. **£8775.00 + VAT**. The main cost has been the cost of the **Oak**. This will be exactly the same as the old fence.
