

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

Statement of the adoption of the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Minerals and Waste Local Plan.

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulations 17 and 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), that Cambridgeshire County Council and Peterborough City Council adopted the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Minerals and Waste Local Plan under the provisions of section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) on 28 July 2021.

The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Minerals and Waste Local Plan sets out the vision, objectives, and policies for the future of minerals and waste development and management within Cambridgeshire and Peterborough to 2036. It also identifies land and allocates sites for minerals and waste development.

Any person aggrieved by the Minerals and Waste Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from the date of adoption (28 July 2021).

The Local Plan was the subject of an independent examination by an Inspector from the Planning Inspectorate, and the recommendations of the Inspector, and reasons, are published in the form of an Inspector's Report under section 20(8) of the Act.

The adopted version of the Minerals and Waste Local Plan incorporates main modifications recommended by the Inspector plus additional modifications (which do not materially affect the policies of the Minerals and Waste Local Plan) made by the Councils.
