Lawn Bowls greens are designed with a perimeter ditch below the level of the surrounds. As a consequence to access the green area players must step down and across the ditch, and conversely, up and across when leaving. Although this is not generally a problem sometimes an elderly player, or someone less able, needs assistance to achieve this safely. To eliminate the risk associated with this we have managed to source some purpose built access equipment which this grant would enable us to purchase.

These steps would add considerably to the amenities of our club and would be appreciated by both our members and players from opposing teams in the fifty plus home matches we play in the various leagues every season.

In addition 2022 is our centenary year and the highlight of our celebratory events will be the visit of the Chelsea Pensioners Bowlers who will certainly appreciate the new 'Centenary Steps'

DESCRIPTION REVIEWS (0)

The enforcement of Law 4 that the bank tops shall be a minimum of 230mm above the green level has produced a large step both vertically and horizontally, to get on and off the green. The steps from Sportsmark have a large stable platform made from slip resistant aluminium measuring 610mm wide x 327mm and then one step down to the green measuring 610mm x 295mm. The base has a plate measuring 610mm x 75mm which spreads the weight evenly to avoid damage to the green edge. Both rear legs can be adjusted quite simply with extendable internal adjustable feet to compensate for different bank heights.

Overall measurements are 700mm x 775mm x 1130mm. The "Hi-Rail" steps have the hand rail extended to give a stable hand grip on both sides 713mm above the main platform. They are produced from rectangular square section steel powder coated green. The handrails have a 45mm wide hardwood varnished top to give a "warm" grip. The steps are supplied in 7 easy to assemble pieces which include all fittings and tool necessary. The access steps weigh 21kg.

Our price includes carriage for the UK mainland, excluding the Scottish Highlands, Northern Ireland and the British Isles where an additional supplement is payable. POA.
