

Melbourn lies in the south west of Cambridgeshire. It has a long history of occupation with archaeological finds dating to Iron Age, Saxon and Roman times. Several ancient trackways cross the parish, and fresh water springs flow into a rare and beautiful chalk stream, the River Mel. The village sign (designed by Mike Keith) depicts John Bunyan, the author of Pilgrim's Progress, who once preached at the village cross.

Our village today is an active, vibrant community. It has excellent travel connections to London and Cambridge and a wealth of facilities and services all set in beautiful rural surroundings.
