Subject: Anti-social behaviour and property damage

Good Afternoon

Thank you for taking my call earlier.

Melbourn Parish Council have received a complaint this morning that requires further attention.

A resident and her young child have experienced anti-social and intimidating behaviour at the Moor Play Park by a group of youths in Melbourn Village College uniform. This behaviour has been witnessed over the period of the last seven days. Behaviour includes – damaging Bowls Club property and using the wood to then attempt to damage equipment in the park, excessive strong language, intimidating behaviour when approached.

Previous reports from the Bowls Club have highlighted the damage to fences surrounding their property but we were not aware of who was causing the damage. This has now been confirmed as youths from Melbourn Village College as the reporting resident has witnessed the behaviour.

Our local PCSO has been informed of the incidents.

Please could you address this with your relevant people and feedback what actions will be taken so that we can keep the Bowls Club and resident informed.
