## Burial charges as from 26 November 2024 for **New Road Cemetery and Orchard Road Cemetery**

### Exclusive Right of Burial (75 years)

Plot	£400
Memorial base or cremated remains	£165

*In the case of stillborn infants or child to age 6 years, and child 7 to 12 years see below*

<i>Stillborn infant to 6 years</i>	<i>Sole burial plot or memorial base</i>	<i>Free – See Note 1</i>
<i>Stillborn infant to 6 years</i>	<i>Double depth plot or memorial base (applies if a future burial is planned)</i>	<i>Free – See Note 1 &amp; 3</i>
<i>7 years to 12 years</i>	<i>Sole burial plot</i>	<i>£200 – See Note 1, 2 &amp; 3</i>
<i>7 years to 12 years</i>	<i>Memorial base</i>	<i>£100 – See Note 1, 2 &amp; 3</i>

[These prices include the issue of the Exclusive Right of Burial certificate. A charge of £25 will be made for issuing a duplicate certificate.]

### Interment fees

Person aged +7 years (first interment)	£135
Second interment and interment of ashes	£75

Notes:

- 1 This concession applies only if there is no intention to use the plot for future interments. If future interments are planned, this should be discussed and agreed at the time of the first interment with the Funeral Director.
- 2 Conditions as per Note 1. In the case of a memorial base/cremated remains base, the charge is reduced by half.
- 3 Normal adult fee scale, interment charges are extra for second adult interment. Normal Exclusive Rights of Burial apply from 13 years.

### Other charges

Erection of headstone	£100
Additional inscriptions	NIL

In the above non-parishioners will be considered only at the discretion of the **Clerk to the Council, and if accepted, all fees will be eight times that of a resident.**

The Clerk must inform all persons purchasing plots that if a flower hole is required in the headstone it must be specified where it is to be in the middle, left side or right side.

New Road is a lawned cemetery, as defined in section 1k of the Cemetery Rules and Regulations – a copy of which must be signed and sent to the Parish Clerk prior to burial taking place.
