NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INSTALL TRAFFIC CALMING IN MELBOURN, AND MELDRETH

NOTICE is hereby given that Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to install raised tables, all 75mm in height according to the below schedule:

Notice of Intention to Install Pedestrian and Cycle Crossing

Cambridgeshire County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to install a 'zebra' pedestrian crossing with a parallel pedal cycle crossing facility under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, centred upon the following locations:-

Station Road, Melbourn at a point approximately 223metres north of its junction with Dolphin Lane.

High Street, Melbourn at a point approximately 63 metres northeast of its junction with Back Lane.

High Street, Melbourn at a point approximately 10 metres west of its junction with Norgetts Lane.

Cambridge Road, Melbourn at a point approximately 25 metres east of its junction with Russet Way.

These constructs are intended to provide safe crossing places for both pedestrians and cyclists.

Highways Act 1980 S.65(1) and S.66(4) Conversion of Footways to Cycle Tracks

Cambridgeshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under the above-named Act, intends to convert part of the footways to shared use cycle tracks in Melbourn:

Around the junction of Back Lane and High Street.

Around the junctions of Norgett's Lane, The Moor, and the High Street.

Around the junctions of Russet Way and Melbourn Science Park and on Cambridge Road, north side, up until a point approximately 275 northeast of the same junction.
