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Hi Alex

See attached reports. First of all, There was very minimal asbestos in the Grays allotments. So that is not so big a deal.

As for the Large allotment site, we already know there is a lot of asbestos debris here, and as we know aswell, the earth gets moved a lot, so the asbestos found last year wont necessarily be in the same place as it was.

The left hand side of the allotments (Plots 1 - 22), there was asbestos found in pretty much every plot, some has a very tiny amount, and some have more. Some of the allotments have the earth covered over with tarpaulins and materials to stop weeds coming through, so there may be more under there, but of course we cant remove them to check.

As for the other side of the allotments (25- 46) This side was a lot worse, with a lot more debris on every plot. We havent taken a photo of every single bit of debris on the site, as the report would be so long it would not be practical to read or understand. Its best to presume there is asbestos debris on every plot, which there probably is.

It will be worth having another pick of the site, as there are some areas which do require attention. I do remember us picking the site a few years ago, and I do specifically remember the right hand side of the allotment site had a lot more debris than the left hand side.
